# The Prince Regent Suite

This is the Castle's largest banqueting suite and can seat from 120 - 280 guests for a wedding. An impressive staircase leads the guests from the front foyer of the hotel up to this magnificent room where a wall of windows overlooks a beautiful private back garden. The suite has it's own private bar area and accesss to the back garden and it's high ceilings and stunning chandeliers create the perfect ambience for a day to remember.



## The Albert & Behan Suite

This Suite can accommodate up to 160 guests for a wedding. # **USEFUL INFORMATION**

In order to hold a Civil Ceremony, the wedding couple must first apply for approval to the Health Services Executive Civil Registration Office. Each couple must apply directly as the hotel cannot apply on their behalf.

# Marriage Notification Process

## Information

Anyone notifying a Registrar of their intention to get married in Ireland must give 3 months notification in person to the Registrar. This applies to all marriages, whether solemnised by a Registrar or according to religious rites and ceremonies. The Registrar does not have to be the Registrar for the district where you live or where you intend getting married. You need to make an appointment with the Registrar in order to give the notification. In order to ensure the notification is given at least 3 months before the date you intended getting married on, it is advisable to arrange the appointment well in advance. If you plan to get married by civil ceremony and a different Registrar will be solemnising the marriage, you must also contact the Registrar's Office for the district you intend getting married in.

#### Rules

Since 5 November 2007, a couple getting married are required to to give notification in person of their intention to marry to a Registrar at least **3 months** before the intended date of the marriage. The notification can be given to any Registrar. When you make the appointment with the Registrar you will be informed what information and documents you need to bring with you. Generally, you and your intended spouse will be required to bring the following:

- Passports or driving licences as identification.
- Original final divorce decree if either of you is divorced. Further information will be required if it was a foreign divorce and you will require an approved English translation of the divorce decree.
- Deceased spouse's death certificate and previous civil marriage certificate if either of you is widowed.
- PPS Numbers

You will also have to provide information about the intended marriage such as:

- Whether it will be a civil or religious ceremony
- The intended date and location of the marriage
- Details of the proposed solemniser of the marriage
- The names and dates of birth of the two proposed witnesses

You will also have to pay a notification fee.

When you attend the Registrar you will have to make a declaration of no impediment.

The Registrar will issue an acknowlegement to both of you and the proposed solemniser of the marriage confirming the date of receipt of notification. This does not give you permission to marry.

If all the information required has been supplied and there is no impediment to the marriage, the Registrar will issue you with a Marriage Registration Form.

## **Guidelines For Marriage Venues**

Civil Registration Act 2004

I, Mary Harney, Minister for Health and Children in exercise of the powers conferred on me under Section 52(I) of the Civil Registration Act 2004, hereby specify the matters set out below:-

- I. Having regard to their primary use, situation, construction and state of repair, the ceremony room and the venue in which it is situated must, in the opinion of the Registrar, be a seemly and dignified venue for the solemnization of marriages. The primary use of a venue would render it unsuitable if that use could demean proceedings or bring them into disrepute.
- 2. The ceremony room must have adequate capacity to accommodate, comfortably seated, the numbers attending the ceremony.
- 3. Section 51(2) (c) of the Civil Registration Act, 2004 provides that a registered solemniser shall not solemnise a marriage unless the venue where the solemnisation occurs is open to the public. Only venues that allow unrestricted public access without charge will be considered for approval, subject to normal security and health and safety considerations.
- 4. The venue in which the ceremony room is situated must conform to all the requirements of any venue open to the public in respect of planning permission, certificate of fire safety, and must meet all relevant health and safety requirements.
- 5. The ceremony room, and the venue in which it is situated must have adequate public liability insurance cover.
- 6. The ceremony room must be accessible to all, in particular to persons with disabilities.
- 7. The venue must have no recent or continuing connection with any religion, religious practice or religious persuasion which would be incompatible with the use of the venue for the solemnization of civil marriages.
- 8. The place in which marriage may be solemnized must be a fixed structure that is clearly identifiable by description and location as a distinct part of a venue.
- 9. The requirement that the marriage be solemnized in a fixed structure that is open to the public precludes marriages being solemnized in the open air, a tent, marquee or other temporary structure, or a private dwelling.
